The Burley Restoration Project is awarded grant from the Building Goodness Foundation

CHARLOTTESVILLE (March 15, 2021) -- The Building Goodness Foundation has awarded a grant estimated at \$6,082, plus additional donated supplies and skilled labor, to the Burley Restoration Project to restore the bleachers.

Through the C'ville Builds program, BGF will repair and rebuild the bleachers in partnership with Hourigan Construction and The Associated General Contractors of Virginia Young Professionals group. Work is estimated to take up to six weeks, with the goal of restoring the bleachers to look like they did during the 1950's and '60s.

Courtney Polk, Deputy Director of Building Goodness Foundation said "BGF is thrilled to be part of this important project, and to play a role in supporting the history and stories of Burley and the African American community in Charlottesville."

H3 Baseball and the Burley Varsity Club have committed to restoring the field and facility at the historic Burley property. The bleacher project was one of the signature projects named. In total, more than \$1,000,000 in projects have been identified in this overall restoration. Included in the master plan are a Walk of Fame to honor past Burley students, teachers and administrators; a mural that depicts life at Burley painted by local artist Sahara Clemons; an all-turf baseball surface; an auxiliary field on the land where Jackie Robinson Little League used to be played; new scoreboard; press box; etc. Burley Middle School and Buford Middle School students are working with the UVA School of Architecture on planning and design.
